

# Safeguarding Training Programs

Clergy and other church employees, as well as those who work with children and youth, are required to take safeguarding programs aimed at

- preventing child sexual abuse – *Safeguarding God’s Children and Safeguarding Online*
- preventing sexual exploitation in communities of faith and preventing sexual harassment of church workers – *Safeguarding God’s People*.
